In 1985, my father, who has enlarged and replanted the vineyard, died, so I left the Law and dived into our vats! And that's how my passion began. On these wonderful steep hills", quotes **Catherine de LOZE** owner and wine grower. To be precise, family archives dating back 1543 have been found in the house! **Château PEYBRUN** terroir, made of steep south and south-west exposed slopes on limestone and chalky-clayey soils, nestled between the Cadillac and Loupiac Appellations, enjoys a truly unique, - unbelievable - non obscured view over the Dordogne and up to the Cap-Ferret lighthouse when the weather is clear.

The 12 acres of red vines beautifully tended and devoted to **Château PEYBRUN**, are located around the small village of Gabarnac, and do benefit a natural drainage and a full southern exposure. Yields never exceed 40 Hl. / Hectare and visiting the vineyard's location once, is enough to figure out the fabulous potential and expression of this unique but rare gem.

We do have a close collaboration with Catherine de LOZE for over 15 years, distributing her famous Cadillac and oak aged Red Cuvée COLOMBE. With this extraordinary vintage, we selected a limited volume made from a specific single 5 hectares plot. to provide from now a **Château PEYBRUN 2009 Cadillac** – Côtes de Bordeaux already offering mouthwatering ripe dark fruits notes, richness, powerful but chewy length with luscious and tasty tannins. All about 2009, all about superb expression of truly unique niche terroirs from authentic vine-growers for you to discover, at the best price.
